Larters is in its 33rd year of operation and the golf course has matured to a level that ranks among the best in Manitoba.

The golf course, built in 1990, was designed to provide challenge and enjoyment for players of all skill levels. The player is faced with numerous water hazards, strategically placed fairway, pot, and green-side sand bunkers. The championship men and ladies layouts play from 5200 to more than 6150 yards. Multiple tees and large greens for strategic pin locations, makes for the complexity demanded by all types of golfers.

Our Pro Shop is well equipped for all of your golfing needs. The friendly, knowledgeable staff are on hand to ensure you make the most of your time at Larters. MEMBERSHIP CATEGORY INFORMATION

CLASS 'A" MEMBER (Yearly dues: \$2,380.00)

- Have 14 days in advance to make reservation for tee times during the week and 7 days for weekends and holidays.
- Have no restrictions from play at any time, except when previous bookings have been made, (ie: Outside tournaments, members tournaments, and members social events) these events will be posted in advance.
- Service package included with dues.

SENIOR CLASS 'A" MEMBER (Yearly dues: \$1,891.00)

(age of 60 years or more)

- Have 14 days in advance to make reservation for tee times during the week and 7 days for weekends and holidays.
- Have no restrictions from play at any time, except when previous bookings have been made, (ie: Outside tournaments, members tournaments, and members social events) these events will be posted in advance.
- ♦ Service package included with dues.

PLAYING SPOUSE (Yearly dues: \$1,680.00)

- Have 14 days in advance to make reservation for tee times during the week and 7 days for weekends and holidays.
- Have no restrictions from play at any time, except when previous bookings have been made, (ie: Outside tournaments, members tournaments, and members social events) these events will be posted in advance.
- Service package included with dues.

FAMILY MEMBERSHIP (Yearly dues: \$4,035.00)

- Includes a combination of any two categories of: Class A, Senior Class A, Playing Spouse, and up to 2 Juniors. Must be immediate family members.
- Refer to Class A and Playing Spouse categories for detailed information.
- Refer to Junior Membership application for detailed information on Junior Category.

Junior Membership (Yearly dues: \$470.00)

- ♦ Have 3 days in advance to make reservation for tee times.
- Restricted; cannot tee off before 1:00 p.m. on weekends and holidays unless accompanied by a 'non-restricted member'.
- ♦ Club Storage included with dues on a first come first serve basis.

SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP (Yearly dues: \$500.00)

- ♦ Receive Five—18-hole game passes .
- Restricted; cannot tee off before 11:00 am on weekends & holidays unless accompanied by a 'full member'.
- Have 7 days in advance to make reservation for tee times.
- Not eligible to participate in member events (ie: Men's/Ladies Leagues, Opening & Closing day Tournaments, Club Championship, etc.).

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

- Corporate 1 Membership— allows the corporation to have up to five (5) employees belonging to one membership. This membership will receive 80 'corporate passes' for the season.
- Corporate 2 Membership— allows the corporation to have up to seven (7) employees belonging to one membership. This membership will receive 105 'corporate passes' for the season
- One service package and one locker is included with each Corporate Membership.
- All registered corporate members have unlimited range privileges.
- Have 14 days in advance to make reservation for tee times during the week and 7 days for weekends and holidays.

CORPORATE 1—(Yearly dues: \$3,500.00)

This membership allows any of the five employees to have booking privileges for the day. One "corporate pass" per member is required for golf per day.

CORPORATE 2—(Yearly dues: \$4,482.00)

This membership allows any of the seven employees to have booking privileges for the day. One "corporate pass" per member is required for golf per day.

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP (Yearly dues \$946.00)

(ages 19 — 25 @ April 1st)

 Has the same benefits as the Intermediate Membership (see below). Student Member does not need to be enrolled in school.

INTERMEDIATE MEMBERSHIP (Yearly dues: \$1,342.00)

(ages 26 - 30 @ April 1st)

- Have 14 days in advance to make reservation for tee times during the week and 7 days for weekends and holidays.
- Have no restrictions from play at any time, except when previous bookings have been made, (ie: Outside tournaments, members tournaments, and members social events) these events will be posted in advance.
- ♦ Service package include with dues.

INTERMEDIATE CLASS 'A' MEMBERSHIP (Yearly dues: \$1,559.00) (ages 31 – 40 @ April 1st)

- \$300.00 of yearly dues is applied to "Initiation Fee" and can be applied to Class A status once member reaches 40 years of age.
- Have 14 days in advance to make reservation for tee times during the week and 7 days for weekends and holidays.
- Have no restrictions from play at any time, except when previous bookings have been made, (ie: Outside tournaments, members tournaments, and members social events) these events will be posted in advance.
- Service package include with dues.

RULES & REGULATIONS

GENERAL MATTERS

- All members and guests are required to register in the golf shop (15 minutes) before play begins.
- All players must start at the #1 tee unless otherwise instructed by the Pro Shop.
- Play in more than foursomes is prohibited unless approved by the Pro Shop.
- ♦ The Pro Shop shall have full responsibility and authority for starting players and regulating play. Their decisions are final, including removal of players not following the rules and regulations.
- ♦ Each player must have a set of clubs.
- ♦ Our club is 'Soft Spike' only

THE DRESS CODE

MEN:

- Shirts with collars and sleeves at all times on the course.
- No sleeveless shirts of any kind
- Tennis, Bermuda, and walking shorts allowed.
- No sweat-pants, cut-off's, running shorts, gym shorts, or bathing suits allowed.
- Proper footwear is required at all times.

WOMEN:

- Shirts should have collar or sleeves, no halter tops.
- ♦ Tennis, Bermuda, and walking shorts are allowed.
- ♦ No running shorts, cut-off's, bathing suits allowed.
- ♦ Proper footwear is required at all times.

OUTSIDE TOURNAMENTS

(groups of more than 16 players)

- There will be no outside tournaments on weekends and holidays before 1:00 p.m..
- Tournaments during the week normally tee off between 10:00 am and 2:00 p.m..
- ♦ The club reserves the right to host on average one 'shotgun' tournament per week. These tournaments normally tee-off at 12:00 noon and should be finished by approximately 5:00 p.m.

BOOKING PROCEDURES

- ♦ See Membership Category Information page.
- Members have 14 days to book tee times during the week and 7 days for the weekends.
- We will allow our 'non-member' guests to book 7 days in advance with the use of a credit card.

FOOD & BEVERAGE ASSESSMENT

♦ There is no Food & Beverage Assessment or Minimums Required.

MISCELLANEOUS CLUB SERVICES

LOCKERS & LOCKER ROOMS

- Lockers are included with all memberships, except: Social/ Maintenance Memberships and Junior Memberships.
- Guest lockers are available.
- No additional padlocks are to be used on the lockers, additional keys are available, (for a \$2 fee) if yours is lost.
- No golf clubs and bags are to be stored in the lockers or locker room area. The Club reserves the right to remove any additional locks or clubs from locker room.
- Larters is not responsible for personal articles left behind in lockers past the designated membership season (Oct 31st).

BACK SHOP SERVICE PACKAGE

- Included with all memberships, except Social or Maintenance memberships.
- Includes club cleaning, club storage, pull cart and complimentary driving range.
- ♦ Please see the Pro Shop for more details.
- Corporate memberships receive one Back-shop service package per membership.
- Larters is not responsible for golf sets left behind or not picked up after the designated membership season (Oct 31st).

DRIVING RANGE & PRACTICE FACILITY

- ♦ Included with all memberships, except Social memberships.
- ♦ Will open and close as the Pro Shop opens and closes.

POWER CART RENTAL

- A full fleet of electric carts will be on hand for your riding convenience.
- If you are a frequent rider, there are reduced rates available through "annual cart deals" or "frequent rider cart tickets".
- ♦ Directional signs placed to control carts must be observed.
