What we expect of our Junior Members:

Junior members have access to the golf course seven days a week with three-day advance booking privileges. Junior members cannot tee off before 12:00 p.m on weekends and holidays, unless accompanied by a full Member.

Junior members are entitled to unlimited use of the driving range. This privilege is extended to the junior member only and **does not include friends and family**.
